ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE HORNED LIZARD CONSERVATION SOCIETY

Article One

The name of the corporation is Horned Lizard Conservation Society.

Article Two

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

Article Three

The period of its duration is perpetual.

Article Four

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- a. To collect information about horned lizards, conduct and support research into the causes for the decline of horned lizards, raise funds, build membership, educate the public, buy, sell and lease real property, develop habitat and propagate horned lizards with the aim of restoring their populations.
- b. To conduct such business as may be permitted by the laws of the State of Texas in order to accomplish the purpose of restoring horned lizard populations.
- c. To engage in other charitable activities.

Article Five
